George has only been able to see her twice via video. When she first was admitted into hospital, she was on a ventilator, but could hear and wave to him. The second time, she was sedated, but he still could see her in bed.

George and Raymond, Tess's son, are doing as well as can be expected. He thanks everyone for their prayers. He will let me know when the surgery takes place. Please keep them in your prayers.
