Tess is doing better now and the Doctors are allowing her to go without the Ventilator. She is talking my ear off.... She is still taking Pure Oxygen thru her nose. She needs to get her oxygen intake levels down to around 30% (I believe that's what was told to me) It's a similar situation as she went thru earlier on, and she was successful so the ventilator went bye-bye. She now also has a bit of coughing spasms which she needs to overcome. But since her coughing is getting much better and so is her ability to breath on her own. I can see a very little light at the end of the tunnel and please continue your prayers for a quicker recovery. I know she misses the CDA a lot and is looking forward to her being able to return. It is a very good incentive for her.

As we all know we are now in our New Year of 2021 - I pray that the past is just that - the past - and we move forward with Hope and Joy and Commitment
