**Dear Worthy Regent, Officers and Members:**

I know many of you are getting ready to jump back into action after taking time off. I have a few reminders that need immediate attention.

- 1) I have been approached by several people who have asked for an extension on the deadline for our National Regent's Mass and Banquet. I am so happy that so many of you are showing your gratitude and support for California's own Emily Guilherme. As you know, when you are working with hotels and their catering service, there is little grace in the timelines. They need to prepare for the staffing, order food, etc. With that being said, we were able to beg for an extension, but it is an absolute drop-dead date. If you are planning to attend, you must return the registration form and funds ASAP, and in addition to that, you need to contact Eileen Bagwell, so she can add the numbers in case the Registration Form does not get to her in time. **We are able accept the registrations until August 12<sup>th</sup>**. I know that does not sound like much time, that means, you pick up the phone and contact everyone to make sure every member has the opportunity to attend this once in a lifetime event. Attached you will find the flyer with the information needed for the Mass, the Reception Banquet, the hotel, and the registration form. Make sure you put the people you want to sit with on the same form, otherwise you may be at different tables. Spouses are welcome but need to be listed on the form.
- 2) We have arranged for an "Alive in the Hive" officer training to be held a few minutes away from the hotel the day after the Mass and Banquet to accommodate those trying to kill two birds with one stone, so if you are traveling to the Banquet, you can stay at the hotel and attend training next day. Remember, all members are welcome to attend at no additional charge. The fee is \$100 per court regardless of how many attend. This will be an interactive training, that will be enjoyable and informative for all. We, too, need to plan for supplies and refreshments, so please kindly fill out and return the registration form. If necessary, we will accept payment at the door. Remember, officer training is required for officers, new or returning, but we encourage all members to attend.
- 3) If you are attending the Northern California training on August 21<sup>st</sup>, or Central California training on August 27th those registration forms also need to be returned ASAP.
- 4) And finally, there are very few courts who have mailed in their New Officer forms that were due in May. If you are one of the courts who sent yours in, Thank You, it is very much appreciated. If your court has not yet done so, please send it as soon as possible, as we are trying to prepare the new rosters.
